

2024 Community Scholarship Application

USSCO Federal Credit Union will award four \$1,500 scholarships—one from each community office—to high school seniors who will be continuing their education at an accredited institution, either college or technical school, in 2024.

To qualify, students must have an account in good standing at USSCO Federal Credit Union, fill out this application, attach all supporting documentation, and submit by the deadline to help us review and rank each candidate's background and accomplishments.

Examples of the types of supporting documentation that improve your chances of being chosen to receive a scholarship include—but are not limited to—the following:

- Official high school transcript
- Letters of recommendation from teachers, principals, and other community leaders
- Copies of any awards received—including awards earned outside of school activities
- A short, personal essay on what winning a USSCO scholarship means to you
- We notify scholarship winners by telephone. Be sure to list a current working number. If we are unable to reach you within five business days, we will award the scholarship to the applicant ranked second, etc.

Applications and supporting documents must be received by Friday, 2/9/2024, at 6:00 PM. Four \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded—one from each community office. Scholarships will be presented at each scholarship winner's school awards assembly.
